

Ka'ala Farms COVID Policy

Adopted: October 2, 2020

Staff Kuleana : If I am experiencing any of these symptoms, I will not attempt to come to work or enter the facility:

1. Fever or chills.
2. Cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing.
3. Headache, fatigue, muscle or body aches.
4. New loss of taste or smell.
5. Sore throat, congestion or runny nose.
6. Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea.

Question: In the past 14 days, have you been in **close contact** with someone who has been diagnosed as COVID- 19 positive?

Close Contact defined as: Someone who was within 6 feet of a contagious person for at least 15 minutes starting from 2 days before person's COVID-19 illness onset (or for asymptomatic positive cases, 2 days prior to lab test specimen collection). Also consider a close contact if infected person directly coughs or sneezes on person.

Question: In the past 14 days, have you attended a gathering of five (5) or more people?

Helping you to identify the risk potential of COVID-19 spreading at events and gatherings:

Lowest risk: Virtual-only activities, events, and gatherings.

More risk: Smaller outdoor and in-person gatherings in which individuals from different households remain spaced at least 6 feet apart, wear masks, do not share objects, and come from the same local area (e.g., community, town, city, or county).

Higher risk: Medium-sized in-person gatherings that are adapted to allow individuals to remain spaced at least 6 feet apart and with attendees coming from outside the local area.

Highest risk: Large in-person gatherings where it is difficult for individuals to remain spaced at least 6 feet apart and attendees travel from outside the local area.

Visitors:

There is a risk of spreading and contracting COVID while visiting Ka'ala's properties. We are asking that groups of 5 or more be directed to the following:
